River Soar Trail



This circular route follows the canal and returns on the Great Central Way. The surface of the towpath varies in quality and is not always suitable for family cycling. The Great Central Way is fully paved and suitable for all users.

The route starts at Aylestone Mill Lock and follows the canal through Aylestone Meadows, past the 15th century Pack Horse Bridge and on to Glen Parva Nature Reserve.

ROUTE 2 – Aylestone Meadows to Glen Parva Nature Reserve and Great Central Way 4 miles

Public transport	The Grace Road bus stop on Aylestone Road is close to the Aylestone Mill Lock entrance. Regular services from the city, or inbound from South Wigston, Cosby and Lutterworth.
Parking	There is a free public car park at Aylestone Mill Lock.
Facilities	Pubs and a shop in Aylestone village (via Pack Horse Bridge). Tearoom at King's Lock (open Thu - Sun)
