STATUE OF LIBERTY

Fact: The iconic statue is located at the busy junction of Upperton Road / Western Boulevard. It was created in 1921 to decorate the nearby Lennard Brothers Ltd shoe factory. The company's managing director had visited New York the previous year and was inspired by the original statue, sufficient to want a replica of it. Lennard's subsequently changed name to 'Liberty Shoes'. The factory building was demolished around 2003 and the statue was relocated to the traffic island in 2008.
