
# City Art Walk GraffWerk

Main Route Point of interest

### **Description:**

Take a wonder through Leicester's Cultural Quarter whilst taking time to stop and view the street art transforming the surrounding area. The trail starts at the Curve, situated in the heart of St George's Cultural Quarter, one of the country's leading producing theatres. Meander past the Athena, one of Leicester's centres for exhibitions, live music and events. Wander past The Soundhouse, an independent live music venue, welcoming a mixture of local and touring artists, as well as Leicester Print Workshop, a centre for printmaking. Look out for the dynamic street art, created by local and international creatives transforming the Cultural Quarter. This trail has been brought to you with the help of GraffWerk, the Leicester based street art agency aiming to redefine the visual landscape of the city through the use of street art.

# City Art Walk GraffWerk

Start location: Curve, Rutland Street, Leicester, LE11SB

Time taken: 30 minutes

**Distance:** 0.7kilometres / 0.4 miles

#### **Directions:**

- 1. From the Curve (1), continue straight ahead onto Rutland Street.
- 2. Turn left onto Southampton Street, continue straight ahead.
- 3. Pass the Athena Car Park art murals on your right by Kinos, Bates, Voyder and Inkie (2).
- 4. On the corner of Southampton Street and St George Street stands local music venue The Soundhouse (3). A tessellated wave pattern designed by a Nottingham based artist, Alex Rubes, pays a subtle nod to the buildings purpose.
- 5. Turn right onto St George Street, passing the Leicester Print Workshop (4) on your right.
- 6. Continue straight ahead, crossing over Queen Street.
- 7. Pass the St George Street art mural (5) on your right, designed by local artist MONO and completed by Ruelo. The magpie with a needle and thread focuses on the historic hosiery legacy of both the building and the city itself.
- 8. Continue straight ahead, passing St George Play Area on your right.
- 9. Turn right onto Orton Square. Follow the path ahead through St George's Churchyard.
- 10. Turn left onto Rutland Street.
- 11. Continue straight ahead, passing the Santander Cycles docking station (6) on your right.
- 12. Rutland Street art murals (7) by artists Gent and SMUG and can be seen ahead on your left.
- 13. Turn right onto Wigston Street, passing the Wigston Street art mural (8) on your left, notice the William Morris styled floral pattern.
- 14. Turn left onto Halford Street, take an immediate right onto Yeoman Street. The Yeoman Street art mural (9) by Alex Rubes ahead on the left depicts striking Art Deco.
- 15. You have reached your end destination.

- 8. Philth Chutney Ivy, Wigston Street art mural
- 9. Alex Rubes, Panache art mural
