

# Leicestershire & Rutland Wildlife Trust

Start location: Abbey Park North Car Park, Leicester, LE4 5AQ

Time taken: 40 Minutes

**Distance:** 2 Kilometres / 1.2 Miles

**Description:** 

Take a stroll with Leicestershire and Rutland Wildlife Trust along the banks of the River Soar, part of their Soar and Wreake Living Landscape. Living Landscapes restore, recreate and reconnect habitats to create an environment full of wildlife and rich in opportunities for learning, health and well-being. On the walk you will be looking at the habitats and species that live in, and alongside this urban stretch of river and finding out more about the importance of our wetland habitats for wildlife and nature conservation. After your walk, if you are feeling adventurous, there are many more wild places to explore in and around Leicester – why not head over to <a href="https://www.lrwt.org.uk">www.lrwt.org.uk</a> to find out about their amazing nature reserves and their wider conservation and education work across the counties of Leicestershire and Rutland. 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#### **Directions**

- 1. Looking at the Abby Park Plaque, follow the path through the collection of buildings until you reach the tree stump.
- 2. Follow the path to the right, heading towards the River Soar
- 3. Follow the path parallel to the river until you reach the bridge.
- 4. Cross over the bridge and take the right hand path.
- 5. Follow the river path, cross the road and continue parallel to the river until you cross a small bridge and reach a T junction.
- 6. Take the right path and follow it until it reaches a fork.
- 7. Take the left fork and follow the boards out into the wetland.

You have reached the end of the route.

- 4. Tree Grove by Bridge
- 5. Old Abbey Wall
- 6. Cardinals Meadow
- 7. Abbey Meadows Footbridge

- 9. Artificial Wetlands
- 10. Wetland Walkway
