

Our Park δ Ride services offer a quick, easy and convenient way to travel into the city centre. The three Park δ Ride sites are dotted round the edge of the city and have CCTV in operation.

Simply park up at one of the sites and hop onto the new all-electric branded buses to the city centre which run every I5 minutes.

Travel time is between 10 and 20 minutes.









Leicester park&ride


