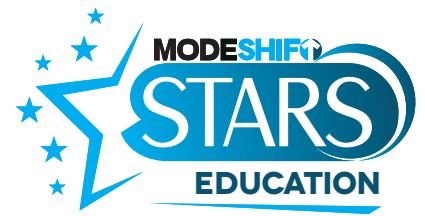

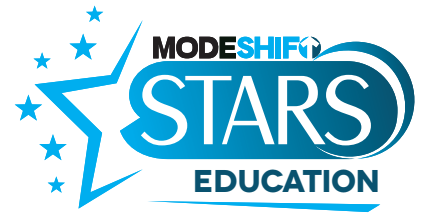

School Travel Survey

Guidance



Choose a normal school day or week to complete the survey, when most students and staff are in school. Ideally all surveys should take place on the same day.

Avoid special events like Walk to School Week as these may unfairly affect results and make it more difficult to achieve STARS accreditation in future years.

For STARS Education accreditation, you must collect responses from at least 80% of students, 70% for secondary schools, and 50% of school staff.

We ask for the preferred mode of travel to help sites assess the potential demand for alternative travel options. This information can be used to inform your Travel Plan, and support the setting of realistic targets for increasing the use of specific travel modes. above travel modes definitions

Travel Modes Definitions

***Walk / Wheel** includes wheeled mobilities including manual self- or assistant-propelled wheelchairs, powered wheelchairs, mobility scooters, and rollators.

****Park & Stride / Walk** is when a pupil is dropped off a short distance from school and completes the rest of the journey by walking, cycling, scooting, or using a wheelchair.

*****Car Share** is when people who are not from the same household travel together in one vehicle instead of driving separately.

Collecting Car Share responses

To provide information on the number of pupils that car share, you may wish to follow the process below:

- ★ **Step one** – Ask your students “Who usually travels by car?” and note down the total number of pupils travelling to school by car
- ★ **Step two** – Advise students “Keep your hand raised if you travelled by car with other children going to school”
- ★ **Step three** – Advise students “Put your hand down if the other children in the car live in the same house as you”. The students remaining is the total that you should enter for the ‘Car Share’ total
- ★ **Step four** – Deduct the ‘Car Share’ total from your ‘Usually travel by car’ figure to give you your final figure for the ‘Car’ total

Please ensure data is transferred into the Modeshift STARS system so the survey counts towards your accreditation.
